### **Submission Requirements**

- Research papers may be submitted in Sinhala, Tamil or English.
- The extended abstract should contain 750–1000 words.
- The document must be prepared on A4-sized paper.

### **Title Formatting**

- Sinhala Medium: Iskoola Pota, Font Size 14, Bold.
- English Medium: Times New Roman, Font Size 13, Bold.
- Tamil Medium: Latha, Font Size 14, Bold.

### **Text Formatting**

- Sinhala Medium: Iskoola Pota, Font Size 12 (including subheadings).
- English Medium: Times New Roman, Font Size 11 (including subheadings).
- Tamil Medium: Latha, Font Size 11 (including subheadings).

### **Submission Procedure**

- The submitted file must be renamed using the author's initials and surname.
- Both Word and PDF versions of the paper must be submitted.
- Each author may publish only one paper as the first author. There is no restriction on participation as a co-author in other papers.

This section should present and analyse the findings of the study. The results may be discussed in relation to previous and contemporary research. The significance of the findings, their social and contemporary relevance, and the final conclusions of the study should be clearly explained.

## **Keywords**

A minimum of three (3) and a maximum of five (5) keywords should be provided.

## **References**

References should follow the Harvard Referencing Style.

Only the three most important sources used in the research should be listed.
